

HANDKERCHIEFS, No. 11

1 ball BUCILLA Crochet Cotton, Art. 004, size 70; BUCILLA Crochet Hook No. 13. (Same for all handkerchiefs.)

First Round: * 3 s. c., ch. 3, catch back to last s. c. with sl. st. to form a p., repeat from *.

Second Round: 1 s. c. in first p., draw up loop about 1/4 inch, thread over, pull through loop on hook, 1 s. c. between the loop and the thread on left side of it, draw up loop as before, 1 s. c. to the left of loop as before (this completes 1 knot stitch), * skip 1 p., 1 s. c. in next p., 1 knot st., repeat from * all around. Put an extra knot st. loop in corners. Third Round: draw up loop as usual, fasten to right of centre s. c. of first knot st. to join round, another s. c. on left of s. c., * 1 complete knot st. loop, 2 s. c. in centre of next knot st. loop,

repeat from *.

Fourth Round: 2 s. c. in centre of knot st. loop, * ch. 4, 2 s. c. in centre of next loop, repeat from *.

Final Round: * 4 s. c., ch. 3, catch back to last s. c. to form a p., 4 more s. c., repeat from * in each loop.

No. 12

Draw 3 threads about 3% inch from edge all around the linen square and roll for a narrow hem. Work over hem as follows: 1 d. c., ch. 2, skip 1/8 inch on hem, repeat all around, join.

Final Round: ch. 3, (2 d. c., ch. 3, catch back to last d. c. for p., 3 more d. c.) all in first sp., * 1 s. c. in next sp., (3 d. c., p., 3 d. c.) in next sp., repeat from *.

No. 13

Roll the edges all around as described above and work over hem as follows: 1 s. c., ch. 1, skip sp., repeat all around. Second Round: 1 d. c. in first ch. sp., ch.

4, another d. c. in same sp., * skip 1 sp., (1 d. c., ch. 4, 1 d. c.) all in next sp., repeat from *, putting extra st. in corners.

No. 14

Roll the edges and make first round as follows: 1 s. c. in edge, * ch. 4, another s. c. in same place, ch. 5, 1 s. c. 1/4 inch from last s. c., repeat from *.

Second Round: 1 s. c. in first ch. loop, * ch. 5, 1 s. c. in fourth ch. from hook to form a p., ch. 1, 1 s. c. in next ch. loop, repeat from *.

No. 15

First Row: * 1 s. c. over edge, ch. 3, another s. c. in same place, skip 1/8 inch on edge, repeat from *.

Final Row: 1 s. c. in ch. loop, * ch. 3, 1 d. c. in next ch. loop, ch. 5, catch back

to top of last d. c. to form a p., ch. 5, catch back for another p., another d. c. in same place with last d. c., ch. 3, 1 s. c. in each of next 2 ch. loops, repeat from *.

No. 16

Make 1 s. c. row all around into hem, placing st. evenly.

Second Round: 1 d. c. in first s. c., * ch. 2, skip 2, s. c., 1 d. c. in next, repeat from *.

Third Round: 1 d. c. in first d. c., * ch.

4, 1 s. c. in second sp., ch. 4, skip next sp., 1 d. c. in next d. c., repeat from *. There will be 2 sp. over 2 sp. of previous round.

Final Round: put 2 s. c., ch. 4, 2 s. c. in

each ch. loop.
