#### Periwinkle Flower



How to Crochet the Periwinkle Flower?

#### **Crochet Yarn**

- crochet cotton #10 colour A = white
- crochet cotton #5 colour B = purple/white
- sewing thread colour C = yellow
- embroidery cotton colour D = green.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

5-lobed purple corolla on a short tubular calyx.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

#### **Tubular centre**



Start: using A and 1mm hook make 3ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch, continue work in round

R1: 5sc in ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: 5sc, join with sl st. Change to colour C, keep colour A on the inside of tube.

R3: make 2sc in each of the 5 sts = 10sc, join with sl st. Change to A, finish off C.



R4: 10sc, join with sl st. Turn on WS. Change to colour C, keep colour A on the outside.

R5: [(1sc, 1dc)] in next sc, (1dc, 1sc) in next sc]x5 = 20sts. Change to A, keep colour C on the outside. R6: working on the front loops only, make (2sl st, 3ch, 2sl st) x 5, join with sl st. Change to colour C, finish off A.



# Petals (5pcs.)

R1: (RS) work on back loops only make 2ch, 1dc, 1sc, 1sc, 1dc, 1ch

R2: (WS) 4sc, 1ch

R3: inc 1sc, 2sc, inc 1sc, 1ch



R4: 6sc, 1ch

R5: 5sc, inc 1sc, 1ch

R6: 7sc, 1ch


R7: dec 2sts-sc, 4sc, inc 1sc, 1ch

R8: 7sc, 1ch

R9: 2sts-sc dec, 2sc, 3sts-sc dec, 1ch, 1o sl st on the edge of petal going down towards the centre of flower, sl st in next back loop.

Repeat R1-R9 4 times to make the 5 petals. Finish off C and hide all tails.

## **Calyx**



Start: using D and 1mm steel hook work on the back of the flower and pick up 12sts-sc from just below the sl st row in colour A, join with sl st, 1ch and continue in round

R1: 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: same; R3: same; R4: same;

R5: (skip 1sc, 1sc)x6 = 6sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R6: (skip 1sc, 1sc)x3 = 3sc, and continue working in spiral 9sc. Finish off.

#### Conclusion

## **Alpine Clematis**



# How to Crochet the Alpine Clematis Flower? Crochet Yarn

- crochet cotton #5 colour A = white
- crochet cotton #5 colour B = blue
- embroidery cotton colour C = yellow.

#### **Crochet Hook**

2mm steel hook.

## **Details of components**

4 blue sepals surrounding white petals and yellow stamens.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

# Petals (5pcs.)



Start: using A and 2mm hook

R1: (2ch, skip 1ch, 1dc in the first ch)x5

R2: (5ch, 4dc, 1sl st in the dc, 1sl st in next dc)x5. Change to colour B, finish off A.

## Stamens (5pcs.)



R1: (7ch, 6sl st)x5. Finish off C.

# Sepals (4pcs.)



Start: using B and 2mm hook

R1: 17ch, skip 1ch, 15sc, 3sc in the next st and continue with 13sc on the other edge of petal and 2sts-sc dec, skip last st, 1ch

R2: 4sl st, 11sc, 3sc in next st, 13sc, 2sts-sc dec, skip last st, 1ch

R4: 4sl st, 11sc, 3sc in next st, 11sc, 1sl st. Finish off colour B. Make 4 sepals.

#### **Assembly**

Roll the stamens, then the petals and secure them together. Position two of the sepals opposite to each other and secure then to the centre piece. Position the remaining two sepals between the first sepals and secure them all.

# **Clematis Brachiata Crochet Pattern**



#### **How to Crochet the Clematis Brachiata Flower?**

#### **Crochet Yarn**

- crochet cotton #5 colour A = white

2mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

4 pointed white sepals surrounding a big puff of yellow stamens.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

#### **Stamens**



Start: using A loop the yarn 12 times over the tips of two fingers.

## Sepals (4pcs.)



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 6ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R1: (1sc in the ring, 10ch, 1sl st in the  $3^{rd}$  ch, 1sc, 1hdc, 4dc, 1hdc) x4 = 4 sepals. Make 1 sl st in the first sc. Finish off colour A.

#### **Assembly**







Turn the sepals on WS, so that the sepals will curl downwards.

Pull the stamens through the sepals' ringand secure them at back of ring. Slit the loops open and spread the stamens. Colour the tips of the stamens with an orange/brown marker.

# Sepals (4pcs.)



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R1: make 8sc in the ring, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R2: (1sc, 2sc in next sc)x4 = 12sts, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R3: 12sc, join in ring with sl st



R4: same; R5: same

R6: (5ch, 4sts-trtr cluster as follows: 1 trtr in same st, 2 trtr in each on next 2sts, 1trtr in next st; 1picot, 6ch, 1 sl st in same st, 1 st st in next st)x4 = 4 sepals Finish off colour A.

#### Stem

Start: using B and 2mm hook, make 12ch, skip 1st ch, make sl st in next 11ch = 11sts. Finish off colour B.

#### Assembly





Pull the stem through the centre of flower and make a knot at end of it. Turn the sepals a little bit upwards at the tip.

- Kid silk colour A = light green

2mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

- green ball-shape stigma in the centre of the flower surrounded by a ring of yellow stamens
- 4 white sepals.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

# **Green Stigma Ball**



Start: using 2 ends of colour A and 2mm hook make 3ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch

R1: 6sc in the ring, join with sl st

R2: (1sc, 2sc in next sc)x3 = 9sts, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R3: 9sc, join in ring with sl st

R4: same; R5: same

R2: (3sts-sc dec) x4 to close the hemisphere. Finish off A.

#### **Sepals**



Start: using C and 2mm hook make 16ch, join with sl st in ring, 1ch

\_R1:4sc, 1ch; R2: 4sc, 1ch; R3: inc to 6sc, 1ch; R4: inc to 8sc, 1ch;

R5: 8sc, 1ch; R6: inc to 10sc, 1ch; R7: inc to 12sc, 1ch; R8: 12sc, 1ch;

R9: 12sc, 1ch; R10: 12sc, 1ch; R11: 3sts-sc dec, 6sc, 3sts-sc dec = 8sts, 1ch;



R12: 2sts-sc dec, 4sc, 2sts-sc dec = 6sts, 1ch.

R13: 2sts-sc dec, 2sc, 2sts-sc dec = 4sts, 1ch.

Make 13sl st on the edge of sepal to get back to the ring.


Repeat from \_ 3 times to make the 4 sepals.

After finishing the last sepal, on each of the 4 sepals make: 7sc, 2dc in each of the next 16 sts and 7sl sts on the edge of the sepal towards the centre of the flower. Finish off C.





#### **Stamens**



Cut about 40 pieces thread in colour B and 8cm in length (3 strands only). Thigh a knot at each end and pull each piece through at the top side of ring.

## **Assembly**

Position the ball piece in the sepals' ring and stitch them all together.

#### **Wild Onion Crochet Pattern**



# How to Crochet the Wild Onion Flower? Crochet Yarn

- crochet cotton #5 colour A = white
- embroidery cotton colour B = green
- sewing thread colour C = yellow.

#### **Crochet Hook**

2mm steel hook.

# **Details of components**

- 6 pointed white tepals with green veins running through the middle
- yellow stamens.

## **Crochet Pattern**

**Tepals** 



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 6ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch

R1: (1sc in the ring, 10ch, 1sl st in the  $3^{rd}$  ch, 1sc, 1hdc, 4dc, 1hdc) x3 = 3 tepals. Make 1 sl st in the first sc. Finish off colour A.

Make two groups of 3 tepals each.

Thread a tapestry needle with colour B, anchor the thread at the base of a tepal (WS), then anchor the thread on the tepal about 1cm from the tip. Work blanket sts all the way back to the tepals' ring using the thread as a core. Poke into the tepal half way in order to make the vein stick to it. Make these veins on each of the tepals.





#### **Stamens**



Cut 3 pieces thread in colour C and 5cm in length. Thigh a knot at each end.

## **Assembly**



Overlap the two tepals' rings such that you will be able to see the 6 tepals.

Fold the stamens and pull them through the sepals' rings. Fold the tepals in a bell shape and sticth everything together to keep it in shape.

- green central column and yellow polen
- 5 long and twisted green sepals and petals
- 1 big labellum, clam shell shape and with a striped green & purple pattern.

#### **How to Crochet the Erica Flower?**

#### **Crochet Yarn**

embroidery cotton colour A = pink, colour B = dark pink, colour C = green.

#### **Details of components**

long, tube-shaped pink flowers on a spike.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

## **Crochet Flower Bud (style 1)**



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R1: make 8sc in the ring, join in ring with sl st, 1ch,

R2: 8sc, join in ring with sl st, 1ch. Repeat 8 more times; Change to colour B, finish off colour A.

R11: 8sc, join in ring with sl st, 1ch; R12: 8sc, join in ring with sl st, 1ch

R13: 2sts-sc dec x 4. Finish off colour B.

## **Crochet Flower Bud (style 2)**



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch,

R1: make 8sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch,

R2: 8sc, join in ring with sl st, 1ch. Repeat 10 more times.

R13: [(1sc, 1dc)] in the next sc, (1dc, 1sc) in the next sc]x4 = 4 petals. Finish off colour A.

I made 4 buds in style 1 (different lengths) and 1 bud style 2.

#### Sepals



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 5ch, make 4 picot and join with sl st in the 5<sup>th</sup> ch. Make sepals for each of the flower buds.

# Stalk



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch,

R1: make 4sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch. Continue work in spiral for 3inches. Dec to 1 st and finish off A.

# Assembly

Attach the sepals to the flower buds and then attach the chains to the stalk.

# **Poroporo Flower Crochet Pattern**



# How to Crochet the Poroporo (Kangaroo Appple) Flower? Crochet Yarn

- embroidery cotton colour A = violet, colour C = yellow
- crochet cotton Size #5 colour B = white; Size #10 colour B = white.

#### **Crochet Hook**

- 1mm steel hook
- 2mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

- large 5-petal flowers with a white centre; petals are notched at the tip
- polen clusters in the centre and a white stigma in the middle of them all.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

#### **Crochet Petals**



Start: using B Size #5 and 2mm hook, make 5ch, join with sl st, 1ch,

R1: 10sc in ring, join with sl st, 1ch. Change to colour A, finish off B.

R2:  $(2sc in next sc, 1 sc) \times 5 = 15sts$ , join with sl st, 1ch

R3: (1sl st in next sc, 4ch, 1picot, 4sts-tr cluster as follows: 1 tr in same sc, 2tr in next sc, 1tr in next sc, 4ch and sl st in same sc) x = 5 petals. Finish off A.

We'll crochet some white veins running through the centre of the petals, a stigma and the polen clusters.

## Centre piece: Stigma, Polen and White Veins



Start: using Size #10 colour B and 1mm hook, make 5ch, 1 small clone knot and return to first ch with 4sl st = stigma. Change to colour C, do not cut off B.



Using colour C and 1mm hook make (4ch, 1 big clone knot)x3 = 3 stamens. Keep the stigma in the centre and join with sl st. Change back to colour B and finish off colour C.

Using colour B size #10 and 1mm hook, make 10ch, join with sl st, 1ch



R1: work in ring (5ch, 4sl st, 2sc in the ring)x4, 5ch, 4sl st, 1sc in the ring, join with sl st in the first ch of row = white veins. Finish off B.

#### Assembly

Position the centre piece inside the petal ring such that the veins land in the middle of the petals.

- pink filaments with stamens.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

Eléonore's design is quite interesting. She used it as a tassel for a lovely bag. I followed the instructions almost entirely and had very little to modify. I used the pattern for the flower tasssel and for a small leaf.

## **Fuchsia Tassel**



Start: using colour A and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join in ring with sl st

R1: make 8dc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: make 2dc in each 8sts = 16sts, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: 16dc, join with sl st, 1ch

R4: same

R5:  $(2sts-dc dec, 2dc) \times 4 = 12sts$ , join with sl st, 1ch

R6:  $(2sts-dc dec, 1dc) \times 4 = 8sts$ , join with sl st

R7: 2ch, (3ch, 2dc) x 4, join in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from start of row

R8: 2ch, (1ch, skip 1 st, make 2tr, 3ch, 2tr in the 3ch-sp from last row, 1ch, skip 1 st, 1dc between the 2 dc from last row) x 4, join in the  $2^{nd}$  ch from start of row

R9: 2ch, make (3ch, skip 2 sts, make 2tr in the 3ch-sp from last row, 3ch, turn, skip 2 sts, 1dc in the 3ch-sp, turn, 2 tr in the 3ch-sp as at beginning of row; make 3ch, skip 2 sts, 1dc in the 1ch, skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next 1ch)x4, join in the  $2^{nd}$  ch from start of row. Fasten off colour A.





## Stem and small leaf



Start: using colour C and 2mm hook, make 7ch

#### Leaf

Make 10ch, turn, skip 2ch, make 6sc, 1ch to cross the stem, pivot and make 1dc, 4tr, 2dc, 1ch, turn and down the other side make 2dc, 4tr, 1dc, 1sc in the stem to finish the leaf.



Make 26ch and make another leaf. When finished, make 8ch and join it to the top of the flower using sl sts.

## **Filaments and Stamens**



Cut 4 x 8inches lengths of colour B and knot the ends. Fold in half, thigh together, pull and attach inside the bell.

- pink filaments with stamens.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

#### **Fuchsia Flower Crochet Petals**



Start: using colour B and 2mm hook,

R1: (make 3ch, skip 2ch, 1sl st in the next ch) x 9. Change to colour A, 1ch, turn and work only in the 3ch-sp

R2: (1sc, 1dc, 2tr, 1dc, 1sc) x 3 = 3 small petals, (1sc, 3ch, 4dtr, 3ch, 1sc) x 3 = 3 med petals, (1sc, 5ch, 5dtrtr, 5ch, 1sc) x 3 = 3 large petals. Finish off colour A.



## Stigma



Cut off one piece colour B, 31/2 inch long and make 2ch at one end. Change to colour C and make 1 clone knot. Fasten off C. Finished length 21/2 inch.

#### **Filaments and Stamens**

Cut 4 x 31/2inches lengths of colour B and knot the ends.



## Assembly

Roll the petals, the small ones on the outside.



Fold the filaments in half, and together with the stigma piece pull and secure them inside the petals' bell.

#### Stem and small leaf

Start: using colour D and 2mm hook, make 7ch

#### Leaf

Make 10ch, turn, skip 2ch, make 6sc, 1ch to cross the stem, pivot and make 1dc, 4tr, 2dc, 1ch, turn and down the other side make 2dc, 4tr, 1dc, 1sc in the stem to finish the leaf.



Make 20ch and make another leaf. When finished, make 10ch, skip 3ch and join in the ring using sl sts, 1ch. Continue in round.

R1: 4sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: same. Change to colour B and continue with the sepals.

#### **Crochet Fuchsia Sepals**

R1: 4sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: same.

R3: make 2dc in each 4sts = 8sts, join with sl st, 1ch

Turn work.

R4: (1sc, 12ch, skip 1ch, make 1sl st, 3sc, 3hdc, 4dc, 1sc in next sc in ring) x 4 = 4 sepals.

R2: 10ch, skip 1ch, 2sl st, 7sc, 1sl st in the next sc in the ring, 1ch, turn

R3: in front loops only, skip 1sc, 7sc, 3ch, turn

R4: 2sl st, 1sl st in the next sc in the ring, 1ch, turn.

Repeat R3-R4 3 more times. Continue working in front loops only, skip 1sc, 7sl st.

Fasten off A.

## **Gentian Flower Corolla (5 petals with fringes)**



Start: using colour C and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 5sc, join with sl st, 1ch. Repeat 5 more times.

R7: change to colour B and make 5sc, join with sl st, 1ch,

R8: 5sc, join with sl st, 1ch,

R9: change to colour C and make:



R10: 4ch, turn, skip 1ch, 2sl st, 1sc, sl st in next sc in ring. Repeat 4 more times.

Work on the back of the little fringes, make \_1sl st at back of fringe, 7ch, turn, skip 1ch, 1sc, 2dc, 1tr, 1dc, 1sc. Repeat from \_4 more times = 5 petals. Fasten off colour B.

# Assembly

Insert the corolla into the tubular calyx and secure them together.

R1: 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: inc to 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R4: 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R5: 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch, turn

R6: [(1sc, 1hdc, 1dc)] in next sc, (1dc, 1hdc, 1sc) in next sc] x 6 = 6 tepals. Fasten off B.





# Stigma and Stamens Centre Piece



Start: using cotton Size #10 colour B and 1mm hook, make 6ch, 1 small clone knot and return to first ch with 5sl st = stigma. Change to colour C, fasten off B.

Using colour C and 1mm hook make (2ch, 1 big clone knot)x4 = 4 stamens. Keep the stigma in the centre, roll and join with sl st.





Stem (2pcs.)



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 8ch, skip 1st ch, make sl st in next 9ch = 9sts. Fasten off A.

## **Main Stem**



Start: using A and 2mm hook, make 3ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: work 3sc in spiral to cover a wire piece of 15cm (6inches). Dec to 2sts and continue for another 2cm ( $\sim$ 1inch). Fasten off A.

# Assembly

Stitch the little stems to the tip of two bells and the third bell to the tip of the main stem.

R1: 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: 2sc, (1hdc, 2dc), (3tr), (2dc, 1hdc), 1sc, join with sl st, change to colour B, finish off A

R3: 1sc, (2hdc), (2dc, 1tr), (2tr, 1dtr), (3dtr), (2dtr, 1tr, 3ch, sl st), (1sl st, 3ch, 1tr, 2dtr), (3dtr), (1dtr,

2tr), (1tr, 2dc), (2hdc), 1sc, join with sl st. Fasten off B.



#### Small Petals (2pcs.)

Start: using 2mm hook and colour B make 2ch



R1: skip 1ch, 3sc in the next ch, 1ch, turn

R2: inc 1sc, 1sc, inc 1sc, 1ch

R3: inc 1sc, 3sts-sc dec, inc 1sc, 1ch

R4: inc 1sc, 3sc, inc 1sc, 1ch

R5: 7sc, 1ch

R6: 2sc, 3sts-sc dec, 2sc, 1ch

R7: 1sc, 3sts-sc dec, 1sc, 1ch R8: 3sts-sc dec. Fasten off B.

#### Stem and sepals

Start: using C and 2mm hook, make 6ch, skip 1st ch, make sl st in next 5ch = 5sts.



Make (6ch, skip 1ch and make 1sl st, 2sc, 1hdc, 1sc) in the next ch, 1sl st in the beg ch and continue with (6ch, skip 1ch and make 1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1tr, 1dc). Join with sl st into the first sepals beg ch. Fasten off C.

## Assembly

The small petals shape naturally into two tiny boats due to the increase and decrease.



Thread a needle with B, place the two small petals opposite to each other to form a nut shape and start stitching the edges together. You may stuff the nut-shape petal with Poly fill to be easier to keep it in shape.

Place the nut shape onto the WS of the big petal and stitch the two together.

Place the sepals onto the back of the petals, the smaller sepal position to the bottom of the nut-shape petals.

## How to Crochet a Golden Columbine Flower?

#### **Crochet Yarn**

embroidery cotton colour A = yellow, colour B = green.

#### **Crochet Hook**

2mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

- flower with five yellow pointed sepals, 5 yellow petals with long spurs
- yellow stamens at the centre of the flower.

# **Crochet Pattern**

#### Sepals (5pcs.)

Start: using 2mm hook and colour A, make 5ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 10sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: (1sc in the ring, 12ch, 1sl st in the  $3^{rd}$  ch, 1sc, 1hdc, 4tr, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc in the next sc in the ring) x5 = 5 sepals. Make 1 sl st in the first sc. Finish off colour A.





#### Petals (5pcs.)

We're going to crochet the petals one by one starting from the end of then spur.

The spur will be a tubular piece crocheted on 3stitches and with a length of 2.5cm (1inch). After this length is achieved we'll enlarge to tube and start working at the trumpet shape petal.

#### Spur

Start: using 2mm hook and colour A make 2ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, make 2sc in next ch, join with sl st, 1ch R1: work 2sc and continue in spiral (no joining) increasing 1sc from time to time until piece measures 2 inches and you have 9sts in the top round. Join with sl st, 1ch. From now on we'll work row by row turning work at end of row.



Turn work.

R1: 9sc, 1ch

R2: 2-st sc dec, 2sc, (1sc, 1sc, 1sc), 2sc, 2-st sc dec, 1ch

R3: 9sc, 1ch

R4: 3-st sc decrease, 2tr in the next sc, (1tr, 1picot, 1tr, 1tr) in the next sc, 2tr in the next sc, 3-st sc decrease. Finish off.

#### **Stamens**

Start: using A loop the yarn 5 times over the tips of two fingers.

## **Assembly**

Turn the sepals on WS, so that the sepals will curl downwards. Pull the stamens through the sepals' ring and secure them at back of ring. Slit the loops open and spread the stamens.



Position the trumpet-shaped petals in the gaps between the sepals with the tip pointing away from the central ring and stitch everything together keeping the stamens in the middle and the sepals spread between the trumpets. A little bit tricky, but with patience it is manageable.

- finishes with small white lobes.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

#### **Flower Head**



Start: using 1.5mm hook and colour B make: (6ch, 1clone knot, 5sl st to return to ring)x10. Fasten off B.

#### Petals (4pcs.)

Start: using 2mm hook and colour A make 8ch, join with sl st, 1ch



R1: make 16sc in ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: (RS) 4sc, 1ch, turn

R3: (WS) 1st-sc inc, 2sc, 1st-sc inc = 6sc, 1ch, turn

R4: (RS) 1st-sc inc, 4sc, 1st-sc inc = 8st, 1ch

R5: (WS) 1st-sc inc, 6sc, 1st-sc inc = 10st, 1ch

R6: (RS) 1st-sc inc, 8sc, 1st-sc inc = 12st, 1ch

R7: (WS) 12sc, 1ch



R8: (RS) 12sc, 1ch R9: (WS) 12sc, 1ch R10: (RS) 12sc, 1ch R11: (WS) 2sts-sc dec, 8sc, 2sts-sc dec = 10sc, 1ch

R12: (RS) 3sts-dc dec, (2dc) in next sc, (2dc, 3ch, sl st) in next sc, (1sc, 2ch, 2dc) in next sc, (2dc) in next sc, 3sts-dc dec, 1ch, do not turn; continue with sl st along the edge of petal towards the ring = 1 petal. Repeat R2-R12 3 more times = 4 petals. Join with sl s at base of first petal. Fasten off A.



At this stage, the petals are ready, but if you'd like to emphasise the notch in the petals, tie in a dark pink colour yarn and make some sl st along the notch.

## Assembly

Roll the little flowers and secure together.

Thread a needle with colour B and stitch the flower head into the petal ring. Shape up the petals.

R1: skip 1 ch, and make 2 sl st, 8sc = 10sts, 1ch,

R2: 2sts-sc dec, 7sc, (1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1tr) = 12sts, 1ch,

R3: (2sc), 4sc, 2sts-sc dec, 4sc = 10sts, 1ch,


R4: 9sc, (1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1tr) = 13sts, 1ch,

R5: 6sc, 2sts-sc dec, 6sc, 1ch,

R6: 10sc, 2hdc, (1hdc, 1dc, 1tr, 1dtr), 1ch,

R7: 7sc, 2hdc, 2sts-dc dec, 1sc, 2sts-sc dec, 1sc, 1ch,

R15: 2sl st, 5sc, 2hdc, 5dc, 2hdc, 2sts-sc dec, 1sl st, 1ch,

R16: 3sl st, 3sc, 2hdc, 4dc, 1tr, 2sts-tr dec, 3ch,

R17: 2sts-tr dec, 2hdc, 4sc, 2sts-dc dec, 2sts-dc dec, 2hdc, 5sc, 1ch,

R18: (2sc), 10sc, 3dc, 2sts-(1dc, 1tr) dec, 3ch,

R19: 2sts-tr dec, 2hdc, 5sc 2sts-dc dec, 1sc, 2sts-sc dec, 1sc, (2sc), 1ch,

R20: 9sc, 3hdc, 2sts-(1dc, 1tr) dec, 3ch,

R21: 2sts-(1tr, 1dc) dec, 1dc, 2sts-(1dc, 1sc) dec, 5sc, 2sl sts, 1ch,

R22: (2sc), 5sc, 2sts-dc dec, 1dc, 2hdc, 3ch,

R23: 2sts-tr dec, 4dc, 2sts-(1dc, 1sc) dec, 1sc, 2sl st, 1ch,

R24: 1sc, 2sc, 2sts-sc dec, 5sc, 1ch,

R25: 3sc, 1hdc, 2sts-dc dec, 1dc, (2dc). Fasten off A.

## Stalk



Start: using B and 2mm hook, make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch,

R1: make 4sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch. Continue work in spiral to cover 7inches of a 9inches piece of gardening wire. Change to colour C, fasten off B.

# **Crochet Spandix**

Make 5sc. For the spikes on the spandix, we'll make picot stitches.

Work in spiral repeating (2sc, 1picot) over the remaining 2 inches.

Dec to 1sc and fasten off C.





## Assembly

Insert the Stalk & Spandix in the Spathe's opening. About ¾ inch of the stalk should be visible inside the spathe. Stitch the sides of the opening to the stalk. Shape the spathe. The flower could be stiffened at this stage, to give it a permanent shape.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1 mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

- cup-shaped blooms with 4 oblong petals
- green long stigma sorrounded by tall yellow stamens shorter than the petals
- 4 sepals: 2 small outer sepals and 2 inner sepals same as the petals.

#### **Flower Pattern**

The crochet pattern instructions you'll find below are for crocheting an individual Stachyurus flower. These flowers are borne in raceme, so you should make as many as you can (10 would be great) and attach them to a central stalk.

Stamens (5pcs.)



Start: using 1mm hook and colour C, make 8ch, make a small clone's knot, continue with 7sl st.. Fasten off C. Make 5 pieces for a flower.

Stigma



Start: using 1mm hook and colour B, make 5ch, make a small clone's knot, continue with 4sl st. Fasten off B.

## **Petals and Sepals**

Start: using 1mm hook and colour A



R1: (make 3ch, skip 2ch, 1dc in the next ch) x 8, 1ch pivot and work in the little rings you've just made (insert hook between the 2ch and dc)

R2: (1sc, 4trtr, 1sc) x 6 = (4 petals and 2 sepals). Change to colour D, fasten off colour A. Make 2ch and insert hook at the back of  $2^{\text{nd}}$ sepal and make (1sc, 4dc, 1sc).

Continue with sl st and ch in the last two little rings and make (1sc, 4dc, 1sc) in the last ring = 2 sepals. Fasten off colour D.

#### Stem

Start: using 1mm hook and colour D, make 5ch, skip 1st ch and make 4sl st, 1ch



R1: make 4sc in the same ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: make 2sc in each of the 4sc = 8sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R6: 8sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R7: same

R8: same. Fasten off D.

## **Assembly**

Position the stamens around the stigma and stitch together.



Roll the petals around the stamens group and secure them all together. Hide all tails under the stem's hut and stitch together. The crochet flower is ready.

#### **Crochet Pattern**

#### **Petals**



Start: using 1.75 mm hook and colour A, make 5ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: [(1sc, 5ch, 2sts-trtr cluster) in next sc, (2sts-trtr cluster, 5ch, 1sc) in next sc] repeat 3 times = 3 petals. Fasten off A.

## Stamens (6pcs.)



Start: using 1mm hook and colour A, make 5ch, change to colour B, fasten off A and make a small clone's knot. Fasten off B. Make 6 pieces.

Puffy Filaments



Wrap colour A around tumb 6 times, pull off the loops and tie them together. Cut the loops open and trim them, so that they'll be shorter than the filaments we just made.

## **Assembly**

Position the stamens around the puff and fasten off. Pull them through the petals' ring. Hide all tails.

R1: 4sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: make 2sc in each sc = 8sts, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: make (2sc in next sc, 1sc in next sc) repeat 4 times = 12sts, join with sl st, 1ch

R4: 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R5: same. Fasten off A.

Make 3 petals.

#### **Crochet Stamens**



Start: using A and 1mm hook, make (6ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, make sl st in next 5ch = 5sts) repeat 5 times to make 5 stamens. Fasten off A.

#### **Crochet Stem**



Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make (11ch, skip 1st ch, make sl st in next 10ch). Fasten off B.

## **Assembly**



Roll the stamens and secure at the base. Position the 3 petals close together, insert the stamens' group in the centre and stitch everything together. At the end, stitch the stem to the back of the flower.

#### **Crochet Trumpet**



Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch, and continue in round

R1: 4sc in ring, join with sl st, 1ch,

R2: 12sc in spiral (no joining) change to A and fasten off B.

R3: using A make 8sc in spiral, join with sl st, 1ch (you have 4 sc on top row)



R4: (make 2sc in next sc, 1sc in next sc) repeat 2 times = 6sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R5: 6sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R6: (make 2sc in next sc, 1sc in next sc) repeat 2 times, make 2sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc) = 10sc, join

with sl st, 1ch

R7: 10sc, join with sl st, 1ch



R8: (1sc, make 3sc in next sc) repeat 5 times = 20sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R9: 20sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R10: (make 2sc in next sc, 1sc) repeat 10 times = 30sc, join with sl st. Fasten off A.

We'll make 5 equidistant ridges on top of the trumpet and finish with a few chains.

#### **Ridges**

Using 1mm hook and colour C starting from below colour B tube, (pick up st and make sl st) repeat 10 times, continue with 4ch.



Make 5 equidistant ridges. Fasten off the threads below the colour B tube only. Squeeze the 5 sides of the trumpet to give it a nice shape.

Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make 6ch, skip 1st ch and make 5sl st; continue with 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch, and continue in round

R1: 4sc in ring, join with sl st, 1ch,

R2: [(1sc, 2dc, 1sc) in next sc] repeat 4 times. Fasten off B.

## Stigma

Start: using 1mm hook and 3 strands of colour A make 5ch. Fasten off A.

### **Assembly**

Secure the stigma inside the ring. Attach the sepals at the back of the bell.

R2: make 1ch, [(1sc, 1dc, 1tr) in next sc, (1tr, 1dc, 1sc) in next sc] repeat 5 times, sl st in the first ch colour A. Fasten off A.

## **Crochet Stem and Leaf**



Start: using colour C and 1.75m hook, make 10ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch and make 9sl st, make 8ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch and make 7sl st, make 18ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch and make 17sl st. Continue with the leaf:



R1: make 18ch, turn, skip 2ch, make 16sc, 3ch, turn

R2: make 3tr, 5dc, 4hdc, 4sc, 1ch, turn

 $R3: make\ 4sc,\ 4hdc,\ 5dc,\ 3tr,\ 3ch\ in\ the\ stem\ to\ finish\ the\ leaf.$ 

Assembly



Stitch the end of the stems to the back of the flowers.

R5: [(1sc, 1dc) in next sc, (1dc,1sc) in next sc], 3ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, make 2 sl st, sl st in next sc on tube, 4ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, make 3 sl st, sc in next 2 sc on tube, 4ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, make 3 sl st, sl st in next sc on tube, 3ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, make 2 sl st, sl st in first sc on row. Fasten off B.

## **Stamens**



Cut 2 pieces colour B, 2¾inches and make a knot at both ends. Pick the loops from the middle and pull them through the tubular corolla. Secure them at back of tube.

- pale-purple daisy like petals
- compact tubular yellow flowers in the centre.

## **Crochet Flower Pattern**

## **Crochet Flower Centre**



Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make 5ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch and make 4sl st back to the start. Repeat 15 times. Fasten off B.

If you roll the flowers between your fingers you'll change their shape making them look more tubular than flat.



Now, roll the flowers with the first one you've made in the middle and secure them together.

### **Crochet Petals**

Start: using colour A and 1.75m hook, make 8ch, join with sl st, 1ch R1: 16sc in ring, join with sl st, 1ch



R2: (10ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, make 1 sl st, 1sc, 7hdc, sl st in next sc in ring in the front loop) repeat 16 times = 16 petals. Make a sl st to the back of first petal.

Next we continue with a second row of petals at the back of the first row, working in the back loops. This time, we'll not make a full row, but rather just a few petals like this

(12ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, make 1 sl st, 10sc, sl st in next sc in ring in the front loop)=1 petal repeat 3 times, then make sl st in the next 4sc, continue with 3 more petals, sl st in the next 2sc, 1petal and 2sl st. Fasten off A.

# Assembly

Position the cluster inside the ring and stitch together.

R2: make 2sc in each sc = 12sts, join with sl st, 1ch continue in spiral making 54sc, 1ch

R3: (2sts-sc dec, 4sc)x 2 = 10sts, 1ch,

R4: 10sc, join with sl st, change to colour B

R5: 10sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R6: [(1sc, 1dc) in next st, (1dc, 1sc) in next sc]x5, join with sl st in the first colour B sc. Fasten off B.

## **Crochet Branched Stem**



Start: using colour C and 1.75m hook, make 10ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch and make 9sl st, make 8ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch and make 7sl st, make 12ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch and make 11sl st, make 8ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch and make 7sl st. Make sl st in the first ch, to close the branch.

### **Crochet Leaf**



Start: using colour C and 1.75m hook, make 16ch, skip first 3 ch and make 6dc, 5hdc, 2sc, 1ch, pivot and continue on the other edge of the chain with 2sc, 5hdc, 5dc, (3dc) in the last ch, sl st in the 16th ch.

## **Assembly**

Stitch the end of the stems to the end of the flowers. Stitch the leaf to the branched stem.

Start: using D and 1.75mm hook, make 6ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch and make 5sl st, 1ch; continue with 4sc in the last ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch, and continue in round

R1: [make in next sc: sl st, 3ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, 2sc] repeat 4 times = 4 sepals. Fasten off D.

### Assembly







Stitch the sepals at back of the corolla.

R1: 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: 1sc, \*7ch, skip 1st ch and make 6 sc, sl st in the next sc on the left, 2ch, turn

R3: 4hdc, 1sc, (2sc, 1picot, 1hdc) in the next sc on the tip of petal, pivot and continue with 2sc, 4hdc, sl st at base of tepal, sl st in the next 2sc in the ring, turn. Repeat from \* twice more to make 3 tepals.

Stamens (6pcs.)



Start: using 1mm hook and colour A, make 6ch, change to colour B, fasten off A and make a small clone's knot. Fasten off B. Make 6 pieces.



Stigma



Start: using 1mm hook and colour C, make 2ch, 1 clone's knot, 2sl st. Fasten off C.

Assembly



Place 3-tepal piece style 1 on top of 3-tepal piece style 2 and stitch together, such that you will have a 6 vertices star. Place the stigma in the middle of the 6 stamens, secure together and pull them through the central ring. Stitch them at back of flower.

I decided to make a pom-pom as the flower head. Instead of the light beige, straw-like colour, I'm going to use a pale yellow. I'll use a couple of card discs with outer diameter of  $\sim$ 2 inches and inner diameter of 3/4 inch.



Wrap colour A around the card discs loosely about 60 times. Cut the yarn, cut between the two discs, while holding the discs tightly. Cut a piece of yarn and slide it between the two discs, pull and thigh with a couple of knots.

The pom-pom is ready.



Next, we'll make one row of bracts.

Start: using A and 1.75mm hook, make 13ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch



R1: 20sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: (1sc in the next sc in the ring, 7ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch and make 7sl st) repeat 20 times = 20 bracts.

# **Crochet Calyx**

Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make 3ch, join with sl st, 1ch continue

R1: 4sc in ring, join with sl st, and work in spiral 16sc, 1ch

R2: make 2sc in each of the 4sc = 8sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: 8sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R4: (2sc in next sc, 1sc in the next sc)  $\times$  4 = 12 sts, join with sl st, 1ch

R5: 12sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R6: (2sc in next sc, 1sc in the next 2sc)  $\times 4 = 16$  sts, join with sl st, 1ch

R7: 16sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R8: same



R9: same

R10: same. Turn and work on WS.

R11: [make in next sc 1sc, 4ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, 1sl st, 3sc, sl st in next sc] repeat 8 times = 8 sepals. Fasten off

For the spikes that cover the calyx we're going to thread in loops of yarn and tie a knot.

### **Assembly**



Attach the puff to the bracts' ring (stitch or glue). Fill in the calyx with poly-fill and attach the bracts' ring.

Start: using A and 1mm hook, make (5ch, 2sts-dtr cluster, 3ch and sc) in the first ch, (3ch, 2sts-dtr cluster, 5ch and sl st) in the ch at base of petal. Fasten off but do not cut off tails. Make 5 petals.

## **Crochet Calyx and Sepals**



Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make 3ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 4sc in ring, join with sl st and work in spiral 16sc, 1ch

R2: make 2sc in each of the 4sc = 8sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: make (2sc in next sc, 3sc) repeat twice = 10sts, join with sl st, 1ch

R4: (1sl st in next sc, 4ch, 1picot, 4sts-tr cluster as follows: 2 tr in same sc, 2tr in next sc, 3ch and sl st in same sc) x = 5 sepals. Finish off B.

## **Crochet Stigma**



For the stigma we're going to make a little ball in colour B.

Start: using B and 1.75mm hook, make 3ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 4sc in ring, join with sl st,

R2: make (2sc in next sc, 1sc) x2 = 6sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: 6sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R4: (skip 1sc, make 1sc)x3. Fasten off B.

# **Assembly**

Position stigma in the centre of the sepals' ring. Secure them together.



Position each petal between 2 sepals, pull tails through and secure together.

Insert the stamens group inside the funnel and stitch at bottom of flower.

R3:  $(1sc, 3ch, 1clone's knot, 3sl st) \times 3 = 3 stamens$ . Fasten off B.

# **Crochet Stigmas**



Start: using D and 1mm hook, leave a long tail ( $1^{st}$  stigma) and make 1slip knot. Continue with 12ch, pivot, skip  $1^{st}$  sc and make 11sl st. Fasten off leaving a long tail (second stigma). Tie yarn at the skipped ch and taking loops on the edge of work make 11sl st. Fasten off leaving a long tail (third stigma). Use a needle tip to spread out the strands of the yarn.

Start: using A and 1.75mm hook, make 5ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch

R1: 1sc, \*10ch, skip 1st ch and make 9 sc, sl st in the ring, 1ch, turn

R3: 2sl st, 2sc, 2hdc, 3dc, (1dc, 1tr, 1dtr, 1tr, 1dc) in the sc on the tip of petal, pivot and continue with

3dc, 2hdc, 2sc, 2 sl st and 1 sc in the ring and turn. Repeat from \* twice more to make 3 tepals.

## Crochet Corolla (3-tepal piece style 2)



Start: using A and 1.75mm hook, make 5ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch

R1: 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: \*1sc, 12ch, skip 1st ch and make 11 sc, sl st in the next sc on the left, 1ch, turn

R3: 2sl st, 2sc, 3hdc, 4dc, (1dc, 1tr, 1dtr, 1tr, 1dc) in the sc on the tip of petal, pivot and continue with 4dc, 3hdc, 2sc, 2sl st, sl st at base of tepal, sl st in the next 2sc in the ring, turn. Repeat from \* twice more to make 3 tepals. Fasten off A.

# **Assembly**



Insert the stigmas in between the stamens and secure to the stem.



Pull the sepals' ring style 1 over the stem until it reaches the stamens' area.

Pull the second ring of sepals (style 2) over the stem and position style 2 sepals between style 1 sepals. Secure together.



You may choose to stitch the tepals at the base slightly depending how closed you want the flower to be. In case you're making a crocus bud, push the two sepals' rings with tepals WS in, so that they'll curl inwards.

Trim the stigmas to your liking.



Stamens (3pcs.)



Start: Using colour A and 1mm hook, make 12ch, make a small Clones Knot and return with 11sl st = 1 stamen. Make 3 pcs.

# **Assembly**

Roll the stamens and pull them through the centre of the flower. Sew them in.

Thread a needle with colour C and sew in a tube the little stem of each tepal. Sew dots onto the tepals in the same yarn.

R7: 1ch, 6sc, R8: 1ch, 5sc;

- continue with sc on the edge of the petal towards the ring as follows: (1sc, 1sc), 4sc


R9: (RS) 5sc, (1sc, 1sc), 5sc, (1sc, 1sc), 5sc

R2: 5sc, 6hdc, 3ch

R3: (at hook make 1dc, 1hdc), 6dc, 5sc, 2ch

R4: 5sc, 6dc, 2ch R5: 11sc, 1ch

Repeat R1 – R5 2 times = 2 petals, join with sl st, 2sl to join the bunch;



## Petals - style 3 (2pcs.)

R1: using A, make 10ch, turn and make (1hdc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1sc), 7sc, 2ch

R2: 8sc, 4ch

R3: (1dc, 1hdc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1sc), 10dc, 2ch

R4: 12dc, 4ch

R5: (1dc, 1hdc in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1sc), 12dc, 2sc, 2ch

R6: 2sc, 12dc, 2ch

R7: skip 1st, 12dc, 2ch

R8: 9sc, 1ch R9: 9sl st, 1ch

Repeat R1 – R9 2 times = 2 petals, join with sl st, 2sl to secure the bunch. Finish off and leave a long tail. Thread a needle with the left tail and stitch around the outer petals to close the flower bud slightly and then secure the base tightly. Shape the petals.





# Sepals

Start: using B, work sc around the wire until almost covered; continue with 4ch, join with sl st and continue in round

R1: 1ch, (1sc, 1sc)x4 = 8sc, join with sl st

R2: 1ch, (1sc, (1sc, 1sc))x4 = 12st, join with sl st

R3: 1ch, 12sc, join with sl st; R4: same; R5: same; R6: same

R7: (7 ch, turn, 3sc, 1hdc, 1dc, skip 1st and 1sl st in the 2<sup>nd</sup> st)x6. Fasten off.



Position the petal bunch inside the sepals' cylinder, push the wire in the middle of the petal bunch and stitch all around with B.



#### **Crochet Yarn**

Crochet cotton Size 5 colour A = orange.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1.75 mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

4 petals orange-coloured flower and a bunch of orange stamens.

### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

## **Crochet Corolla**



Start: using A and 1.75mm hook make 4ch, join in ring with sl st, 1ch

R1: 8sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch,

R2: 1ch, make dc in the next 2 sts, 2ch, turn

R3: 2sts-dc inc, 2sts-dc inc, 2ch, turn



R4: 2sts-dc inc, 2dc, 2sts-dc inc, 2ch, turn

R5: 6dc, 1ch, turn

R6: 1sc, 1hdc, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc, sl st on the edge of petal back to the ring = 1 petal. Repeat from R2 to R6, 3 times to make 4 petals in total.

Make sc on the edge of the petals (3sc in each corner) and fasten off when finished.





#### **Stamens**

Wind the colour A yarn 5 times around the tip of the little finger. Pull the loops off and tie them together. Pull the bunch through the centre of the flower and sew at the back. Cut the loops open.

### **Crochet Yarn**

- Embroidery cotton (6strands) colour A = red, colour B = yellow
- Crochet cotton Size 10 colour C = white.

#### **Crochet Hook**

- 1.75 mm steel hook
- 1 mm steel hook.

### **Details of components**

• 6 petals red-colored flower and a bunch of tall white stamens with yellow pollen, joining the petals on a large base.

#### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

#### **Crochet Petals**



Start: using A and 1.75mm hook make 4ch, skip 1st ch,

R1: 3sc, 1ch, turn R2: 3sc, 2ch, turn

R3: 3sts-dc inc, 1dc, 3sts-dc inc, 2ch, turn

R4: 3dc, 3sts-dc inc, 3dc, 2ch, turn

R5: 9dc, 2ch, turn

R6: 3dc, 3sts-dc dec, 3dc, 2ch, turn

R7: 3sts-dc dec, 1dc, 3sts-dc dec, 1ch, turn

R8: 4sl st, and continue with sl st on the edge of the petal; 2ch = 1 petal.

Make 5 petals.



The last petal is smaller: make 4ch, skip 1stch,

R1: 3sc, 1ch, turn

R2: 3sc, 2ch, turn

R3: 3sts-dc inc, 1dc, 3sts-dc inc, 2ch, turn

R4: 3dc, 3sts-dc inc, 3dc, 2ch, turn

R7: 3sts-dc dec, 3dc, 3sts-dc dec, 2ch, turn

R8: (skip 1st st, 1sc) x 2, 1sc. Fasten off A.



### **Crochet Stamens**

Start: using colour C and 1mm hook, make 11ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, change to colour B and make a Clones Knot, change back to colour C and make 10sl st = 1 stamen. Make 12 pieces.





## Assembly



Roll the stamens and sew them together. Sew the petals around the stamen's bunch.

#### **Crochet Yarn**

- Crochet cotton Size 10 colour A = white, colour C = pink, colour D = dark yellow,
- Embroidery cotton (6strands) colour B = yellow.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1.75 mm steel hook.

### **Details of components**

• 5 petals flower with a yellow centre.

#### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

This pattern is suitable for begginers crochetiers.

### **Crochet White Plumeria**



Start: using B and 1.75mm hook make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 5sc, join with sl st, change to colour A, fasten off B

R2: (1sc in next sc, 9ch, skip  $1^{st}$  2ch, 1dc, 1tr, 1dtr, 1trtr, 1dtr, 1tr, 1dc, 1sc in the same sc as first 1sc from beg of row) x 5. Join with sl st and fasten off A.





### **Crochet Pink Plumeria**

Start: using D and 1.75mm hook make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: 5sc, join with sl st, change to colour C, fasten off D

R2: (1sc in next sc, 9ch, skip  $1^{st}$  ch, 1sl st, 1sc, 1dc, 3tr, 1dc, 1sc, 1sc in the same sc as first 1sc from beg of row) x 5. Join with sl st and fasten off C.

#### **Crochet Yarn**

- Crochet cotton Size 10 colour A = white,
- Embroidery cotton (3strands) colour B = pink.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1 mm steel hook.

### **Details of components**

3 flowers cluster surrounded by 3 coloured bracts.

#### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

#### **Crochet flowers cluster**

Start: using A and 1mm hook \* make 8ch, skip 1st ch, make (1dc, 1sc)x3 in next ch, continue with 6sl st = 1 flower. Repeat from \* twice, to make 3-flower cluster.





### **Crochet Bracts (3pcs.)**

Start: using B and 1.75 mm hook make 13ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, make 12sc, 1ch and pivot R1: 3sl st, 1sc, 3dc, 2tr, 2dc, 1sc, (2ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, 1sl st) in the st on the tip of bract, continue with 1sc, 2dc, 2tr, 3dc, 1sc, 2sl st, 1ch = 1 bract. Make 3 bracts. Join with sl st in a ring at base of first bract.





### Assembly

Pull the flower cluster through the bracts' ring and secure at the back. Block the bracts lightly.

• Embroidery cotton (6strands) colour A = burgundy, colour B = yellow.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1.75 mm steel hook.

#### **Details of components**

small flower 2-4cm wide with 5-6 petals.

#### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

#### **Crochet Corolla**



Start: using B and 1.75mm hook make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: make 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: 6sc, join with sl st, 2ch

R3: make 2dc in each sc = 12dc, join with sl st, change to colour A



R4: [make (1sc, 2ch, 1tr, 1dtr, 4ch, 1 sl st) in next st = right ear, make (1sl st, 4ch, 1dtr, 1tr, 2ch, 1sc) in the next st = left ear] x 6. Change back to colour B, fasten off A



R5: (6sc on the edge of right ear, 1hdc in between the 2sl sts, skip last st on the right ear, continue on the left ear – skip  $1^{st}$  st, 6sc, 1sc in between the 2sc) x 6. Fasten off. Block the flower petals lightly.

#### **Crochet Yarn**

• Embroidery cotton (6strands) colour A = blue, colour B = purple.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1.75 mm steel hook.

### **Details of components**

• flower head with a central cluster of tiny florets surrounded by a few large ray florets.

#### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

#### **Crochet Corolla**



Start: using A and 1mm hook make 4ch, join with sl st, 1ch

R1: make 6sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch

R2: 6sc, join with sl st, 1ch

R3: make 2sc in each sc = 12sts, join with sl st, 1ch

#### Ray florets:



R1: make 1sc in next sc, 4ch, skip 1st ch and make 2sc in next ch, 1ch, turn

R2: make 2sc in each sc = 4sts, turn

R3: (4ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, 1 sl st, 2sc, 1sl st in next sc)x 3, 4ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, 1 sl st, 2sc, in next sc and continue with sl st on the edge of floret all the way back to the 12sts ring.

Make 12 florets. Fasten off.



#### Central Cluster:

Start: using colour A and colour B together and hook 1.75mm, make 5ch, skip 1<sup>st</sup> ch, make 4sc, 1ch, turn make 4sc, cut off yarns. Steam and unravel.



Wind the yarn around the finger, pull loops off and tie them together. Pull the florets through the central disc, secure at the back and cut off loops and trim.

#### **Crochet Yarn**

Embroidery cotton (6strands) colour A = blue, colour B = white, colour C = purple.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1 mm steel hook.

### **Details of components**

small blue flower with a white centre and darker veins.

#### **Crochet Flower Pattern**

#### **Crochet Corolla**



Start: using colour B, make 4ch, join with sl st,

R1: (make 3ch, 1sc)x 4, join with sl st, change to colour A

R2: (work in the 3ch chain 1sc, change to colour C, 1hdc, change to colour A 1dc, change to colour C 1tr, change to colour A 1tr, change to colour C 1tr, change to colour A 1dc, change to colour C, 1hdc, change to colour A 1sc) x = 3 petals, fasten off C.



Continue with the light-colour petal: change to colour B 1hdc, change to colour A 1dc, change to colour B 1tr, change to colour A 1dc, change to colour B 1hdc. Fasten off A and B.



#### **Stamens**



Cut a piece of yarn in colour B, make a knot at each end, fold and pull it through the centre of the flower.

#### **Crochet Yarn**

• Crochet cotton Size 5 colour A = white.

#### **Crochet Hook**

1.75 mm steel hook.

### **Details of components**

4-petal white flowers that you can build in a cone-shaped cluster.

### **Crochet Flower Pattern (3pcs.)**

dtr (double treble = yo three times)

trtr (treble treble, or triple treble = yo four times)



Start: using 1.75mm hook and colour A make 1ch, and 1 clone knot

R1: make 4ch, join in ring with sl st keeping the knot in the middle of the ring, 1ch

R2: make 4sc in the ring, join with sl st, 1ch



R3: work in next st: 1sc, 8ch, 6 trtr cluster, 1picot, 8ch, 1sl st, 1sl st in the next st, work in next st: 1sc, 8ch, 6 trtr cluster, 1picot, 8ch, 1sl l st = 2 large petals.

R4: 6ch, 4dtr cluster in the st between the large petals, 1picot, 6ch, 1sl st in the sc at right hand side at base of 1st large petal, 1ch, 1sl st at left hand side at base of 1st large petal, 6ch, 4dtr cluster in the 1st between the 2 large petals, 1picot, 6ch, 1sl st in the sc at right hand side at base of 1st large petal, 1ch, join with sl st at base of 1st small petal.
